PRM20406 CERTIFICATE II ASSET MAINTENANCE FIRE PROTECTION EQUIPMENT VIA E-LEARNING

Course Overview

The industry has been crying out for a more flexible, self-paced, student-friendly training system that can be delivered to best suit you, the customer. Well, JIST has delivered!

JIST will kick-off its E-learning facility by delivering Certificate II Asset Maintenance (Fire Protection Equipment) PRM20406 via E-learning in September. Successful completion will meet the qualification requirements to satisfy Building Services Authority licensing requirements. This is so flexible that it will provide training that specifically meets your licensing needs. The training can be undertaken at your own pace and in your own environment. The E-learning option will have less impact on work schedules, much less time off the job, without the pressure of sitting in a classroom and offers much swifter progression through the training.

Why Choose This Course?

The Certificate II Asset Maintenance is recognised by the BSA as the successful 'technical requirement' for fire protection licensing in BSA fire occupational licensing classes. This training is designed to meet the following licensing classes -

1. **Portable Fire Equipment and Hose Reels (Hose Reels Down Stream of stop cock only) - install and maintain**
2. **Fire Hydrants and Hose Reels—inspect and test**
3. **Emergency Lighting—inspect and test**
4. **Fire Doors and Shutters—inspect and test**
5. **Fire Collars, Penetrations & Joint Sealing—install and maintain***
6. **Fire Detection, Alarm & Warning Systems—maintain (extra low voltage)**

(* For this license class there is a requirement to complete both the Certificate II in Asset Maintenance **and** the unit REP1. REP 1 will not be delivered as part of this course. Further details on this unit can be obtained from JIST).

How much time will I need to commit?

The time frame is flexible enough to work with you and your current workload and will be influenced by your existing experience and knowledge. Because it's online you can do the course anytime! You will also be required to attend the JIST Training Centre or an alternative location (if you are based outside of SEQ) for a very small amount of time to complete a practical component. JIST will assist you in this requirement.

How much will it cost?

To obtain the qualification you will need to complete eight (8) core units along with four (4) elective units. Selecting the relevant elective units will be determined by your Building Services Authority licensing needs. You can also select extra elective units if you wish to apply for additional licensing classes.

Extra Electives: \$137.50 each

When can I start?

The eight (8) core units will be available September. The elective units will commence mid-October. Please complete an enrolment form and return to JIST so you can start learning!

Assessment

Completion of the course is dependent on the participant completing all assigned tasks. There is some practical assessment of certain units. If you are located outside of Brisbane, JIST will assist you to complete this component. On successful completion of the course, participants will be issued with a Qualification.

Outcome:

Successful completion of this course will allow the participant to apply to the Building Services Authority for a variety of Fire Occupational and Contractor Licence classes.

While there are no pre-requisites for entry into the course the following is recommended -

- An intermediate level of numeracy, literacy and computer skills
- Access to relevant Australian Standards, Codes, Legislation and other relevant documentation
